Text: Matthew 11:16-19, 25-30

Key verse: v.28 Come to me, all you that are weary . . .

Why does Jesus say that the intelligent cannot see what infants can see? What wisdom is this? This wisdom Jesus speaks of offers "easy" guidance and direction. The Kingdome way is not the way of the powers of the world such as the Temple authorities or the Roman Empire. How might we be led today by this Wisdom?

July 12th

Text: Matthew 13:1-9, 18-23

Key verse: v.3 . . . "A sower went out to sow . . . "

What kind of sower just throws seed around like this? Word of the kingdom comes to people in a variety of environments and situations. Who is responsible for the soil and the success of the seed, is it the sower? This sower somehow gets a surprising abundance from the good soil. What surprising results await us in the kingdom of God?

July 19th

Text: Matthew 13:24-30, 36-43

Key Verse: v28 . . . for in gathering the weeds you would uproot the wheat . . .

Darnel, the indistinguishable weed. We can't tell which is which, that is the point. You don't know, who is producing, who is not? It is not our task to separate. Our task is to produce as best we can, lest we become fruitless.

Text: Matthew 13:31-33, 44-52

Key Verse: v33 The Kingdom of Heaven is like yeast . . .

Leven is regarded as unclean, how can the Kingdom be compared to this unclean substance? What does it say about the kingdom of God that these small events create abundance? The first hearers would have noticed this inclusion, what does it mean for us today?

A Virtual Vacation Bible School Experience

We are looking forward to our upcoming virtual vacation bible school, and would love to invite families to begin registering children today! We are planning on August 10, 11 and 12 as the three days of our "Sweet Summer Celebration!"



On day one, a Monday afternoon, we will kick off virtual VBS with a drive-through tunnel of volunteers and revelry in our church parking lot featuring (socially distanced) high school and middle school youth and adult volunteers making a celebration tunnel. The children of our VBS (grades K-5) will join their families in the drive through, get a wacky pack of summer goodies to celebrate our three day VBS, many sweet treats made by our middle school youth, high school youth, and of course youth director Justin Nutting, a hot family dish such as a pizza or fried chicken, and have their picture taken ... again, all while social distancing.
